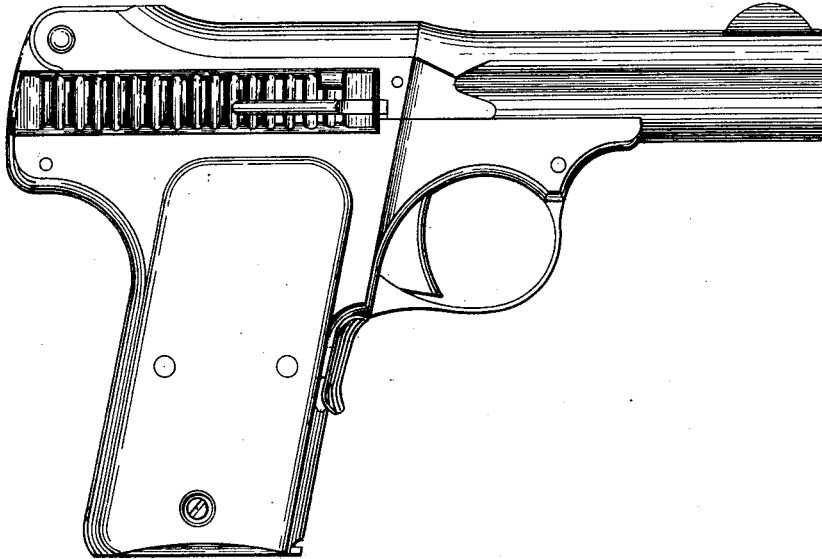

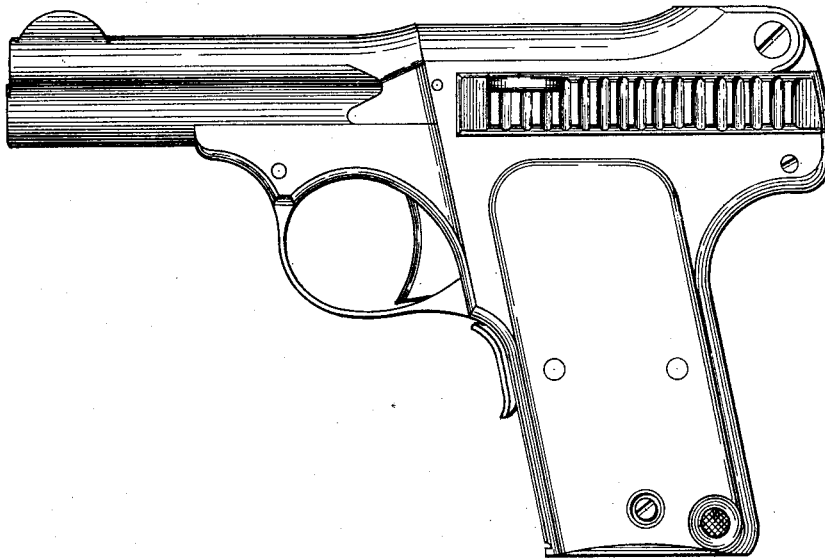

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOSEPH H. WESSON, a citizen of the United States, residing in Springfield, in the county of Hampden, State of Massachusetts, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Pistols, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a side elevation of one side of a pistol, showing my new design; Fig. 2 is a similar view showing the other side of the same pistol.
